2022 Zoning Ordinance Rewrite -- UPDATE

Do you know that the County has been in the process of rewriting the 1993 Zoning Ordinance to match the goals of the 2019 Comprehensive Plan? The next phase of the Zoning Ordinance Rewrite (ZOR) is fast approaching and includes a 90-day timeline for public comment beginning the first week of April.

During the 90 days there will be in person open houses (3 currently planned), one virtual open house and a recorded video tutorial to describe how to enter public comments in the new online ordinance platform (enCodePlus).

That is a short turnaround for a large ordinance that will affect the future of Loudoun for years to come. LCEA will be making recommendations, but we encourage all equestrians to become informed and involved both directly and by commenting back to LCEA.

Equestrian Uses are currently broken into two categories plus a definition: Stable private (definition), Stable livery (use) and Stable event (use)
